From Your Worship Pastor:

February's New Song: "I Speak Jesus"

This month launches Pastor Wade's next series, "The Truth," where the book of Romans will be referenced often. During this series, we're also teaching a new song, "I Speak Jesus," that enhances the truths we will be taught (thank you for learning January's new hymn – "Yet Not I But Christ").

This new song, focuses on the name of Jesus, which we know is the "name that is above every name." (Phil 2:9) Paul links the gospel with Christ being "named," (Rom 15:20) and we call to mind that "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." (Rom 10:13) Without a doubt, the name of Jesus is central to our faith.

But have your ever considered . . . why? Is the name of Jesus powerful because the mouths of humans voice it? Is the name of Jesus important because the phonetic spelling (say, from an English teacher sharing pronunciation with a class) from human lips ("/'dʒi:zəs/") has some inherent power in and of itself? That conclusion would seem to be on shaky foundation logically and make God's followers superstitious (merely saying the word, "Jesus," becomes a rabbit's foot), as well as the realization that our English translations are not the original source language of Scripture – which means "Jesus" has a different phonetic spelling in different languages. So it can't be the phonetic spelling. It must mean something different.

I would propose that Scripture says Jesus' name is important because of what it represents – namely, the person of Jesus. The name of Jesus represents all who Jesus is - his purpose, his character, his entire life's scope. We see this in the healing of the lame man at the gate of the temple:

"By faith in the NAME of Jesus, this man whom you see and know was made strong. It is Jesus' NAME and the faith that comes through him that has given this complete healing to him, as you can all see." (NIV) (Acts 3:16)

This man was healed because of Jesus (his divine life and power) and Scripture records this as being healed in Jesus' name. Similarly, there are other themes recorded in this representative sense. Suffering is mentioned in light of Jesus' name (Acts 5:41; 9:16; 15:26; 21:13; 1 Peter 14,16; Rev 2:3) and coming to saving faith is summarized by this link to Jesus' name (Joel 2:32; Zech 13:9; John 1:12; Acts 2:21, 4:12, 10:43; 1 Cor 1:2). And there are others!

So when we sing:

I just wanna speak the name of Jesus
'Til every dark addiction starts to break
Declaring there is hope and there is freedom
