Meet the new Student

Pastor, Tory Almond.

Tory was approved as Student Pastor on January 5, 2020. His tentative start date is Sunday, February 16, 2020. Below is a portion of the letter sent out by the Pastor and the Search Committee.



Dear Church Family,

For the last several months, our Search Team has reviewed over 200 resumes. At the same time, we've been constantly praying that God would reveal to us HIS choice in HIS timing for our next Student Pastor. During this process, we were introduced to Tory by one of our team members who knew Tory when he was serving in another role here in Greenville. As we have gotten to know Tory, we have come to see why his references are so strong and why he has been so highly recommended. Give him 5 minutes and you'll see why Tory connects so well with all ages, but especially students! Tory is from right here in Greenville, but has spent the last several years in Amsterdam, serving as a Youth Leader and Ministry Director for XRDS International Church and CM Connect, working with international students and assisting understaffed and under resourced churches in Europe. Before that, he has also worked here in Greenville with Off The Coast Ministries and Brookwood Church in student ministries. Tory received his undergraduate degree in Youth Ministry from North Greenville University and his Master of Divinity from Tyndale Theological Seminary in North Holland. Tory enjoys the outdoors, taking photos and eating tasty foods. Tory says of his recent journey: "The past 8 and a half years in Amsterdam have been amazing. And despite the all too often hard times of being a missionary in Europe, I'd not trade it for anything. It will be bitter sweet to leave the people and ministry God has allowed me to be a part of. But, they are excited for me and I'm looking forward to the new adventure, new people, and new opportunities to share God's love with in Greenville. It will be great serving in my hometown with a church that people have described to me as a big, loving family!"
