Letter from your Pastor.....

Dear Mauldin First Baptist Family,

While our world is still dealing with the COVID-19 Coronavirus situation, we as the church still seek to fulfill God's calling to join Him in His Kingdom work to go and make disciples. That's why even though we're doing things very differently than we have before, the work of the church goes on. So I thought I'd give you a few updates...

- 1. We opened again on May 31st! I hope you received the separate letter outlining the details and hopefully answering your questions about how everything was going to take place. Everything seemed to go really well and we are looking forward to Sunday School starting back. While our online services help keep us connected, nothing replaces being together! If you didn't make it May 31, 2020, that's okay, take as long as you need. But I'm really looking forward to seeing you all again soon!
- 2. We're working to find a new Worship Pastor! We are so blessed to have Stuart Thompson, Sami Ninis, James Tegeler and all our band members and tech team folks providing interim worship leadership for us during these challenging times. But I thought you might want to know our Worship Pastor Search Team has continued to meet and pray about finding our next worship leader. We've been meeting via Zoom and have invited some ministry leaders who have experience in these matters to meet with us to share their guidance. We also created some time to hear from some of our current staff members. We want to hear from you too! Feel free to email me your thoughts, suggestions and questions at wleonard@fbcmauldin.org. We ask that you pray for us as we continue this process. We're also reading a great book called "Worship Essentials" by Mike Harland. Would you like a free copy? We would be glad to give you one so you can be reading what we're reading. - 3. We're looking good financially! I know this is hard to believe, but after more than two months of being out of church and more than 1/3 of the way through the year, we are actually AHEAD of budget and ahead of last year's pace of giving! Now granted, the economic and unemployment news isn't too good and there may be hard times coming in the near future. Which is why our Finance Team has also continued to meet as we monitor this crisis very carefully. Our cash position is strong, but we are working to curtail unnecessary expenses should we face leaner times later in the year. We are thankful for your generous, sacrificial and consistent giving! Please continue to do so as we continue to fund our ministries and support our missionaries.
- 4. We're all pastors now! Personally, one of the hardest things for me during this time has been not being able to go to the hospital when you are having surgery, or to come pray with you or minister to you during a death or loss in your family. But I've been so encouraged and inspired to hear your testimonies as to how you are ministering to each other within your families and small groups. Please continue to check in on each other and find ways to share the love of God with those around you.


