From Your Worship Pastor:

Worship - The True Center of the Mark

Conversations about worship can be divided, according to Chuck Swindoll, into two categories called expression and essence. Usually, these conversations are dominated by the expression category – which translates to the songs we sing and the instrumentation used to accompany those same songs. Yet, expressions of worship can easily devolve into matters of preference and God's people can get swept away by this never-ending vortex. But that's where the essence of worship comes into our discussion. The essence of worship starts with a different question: What pleases God in our worship? We talked about this in our recent Worship Arts relaunch event. What does God want? Does it matter to God whether our melodies are 5 months old or 500 years old? Rev. 2 gives part of the answer:

I know your deeds, your hard work and your perseverance. I know that you cannot tolerate wicked people, that you have tested those who claim to be apostles but are not, and have found them false. You have persevered and have endured hardships for my name, and have not grown weary. Yet I hold this against you: You have forsaken the love you had at first. (Rev. 2:2-4)

According to this passage, we may exhibit many outstanding character traits but miss the main purpose. We may display much-needed spiritual discernment, endurance, perseverance, and a great work ethic but dismiss the core value of our "first love." God calls this dismissal "sin" and reason enough to remove the "lampstand" from a local church. This lesson is a sobering reminder of what can happen when we leave our "first love." It can happen to any of us. We subtly replace our love for God with work/tasks/correct belief systems. Augustine called this problem "disordered loves." We take something that is good and we make it ultimate – our loves are out of order. There is only one that deserves to be "first" in our love. This is why all the law and the prophets can be summarized by whether we love God first or not.

So let's be vigilant and aware of the enemy's schemes. Let's not lose the essence of true worship by getting sidetracked with the expression of worship. Songs of worship are important, but they are not ultimate. God is ultimate and pleasing Him in our worship is our highest priority.

Watch Mauldin First Baptist "Live" and "On-Demand" on Your TV

Mauldin First Baptist has a new Roku Channel where you may watch "live" and "on-demand" videos of our church worship services, Sunday School, information, and other events. Watching via a Roku Streaming Media Player allows you to watch from the comfort of your living room on your TV. Roku is an internet connected device and requires that you have wireless internet via a router in your home. There are several different models that are available. We recommend either the Streaming Stick or the Liltra

The Roku Ultra also requires a separately purchased HDMI cable that is available from retailers such as Best Buy, Wal-Mart, Office Depot orBH Photo Video.

After you install your Roku, you will need to go through the settings to connect it to your wireless signal from your router. Once connected, "search" and "add" the "Mauldin First Baptist" channel.
